Read Galatians 5:16-26

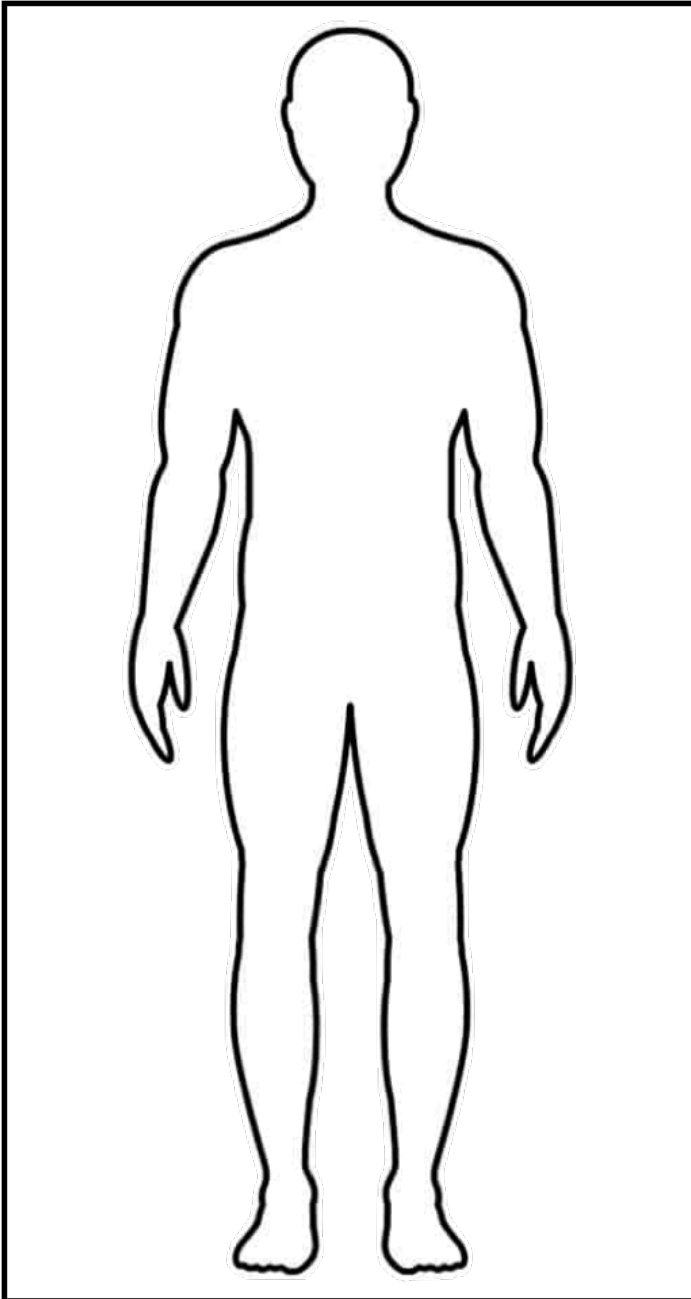
16.What is the nature of indwelling sin?

17. How is it overcome?

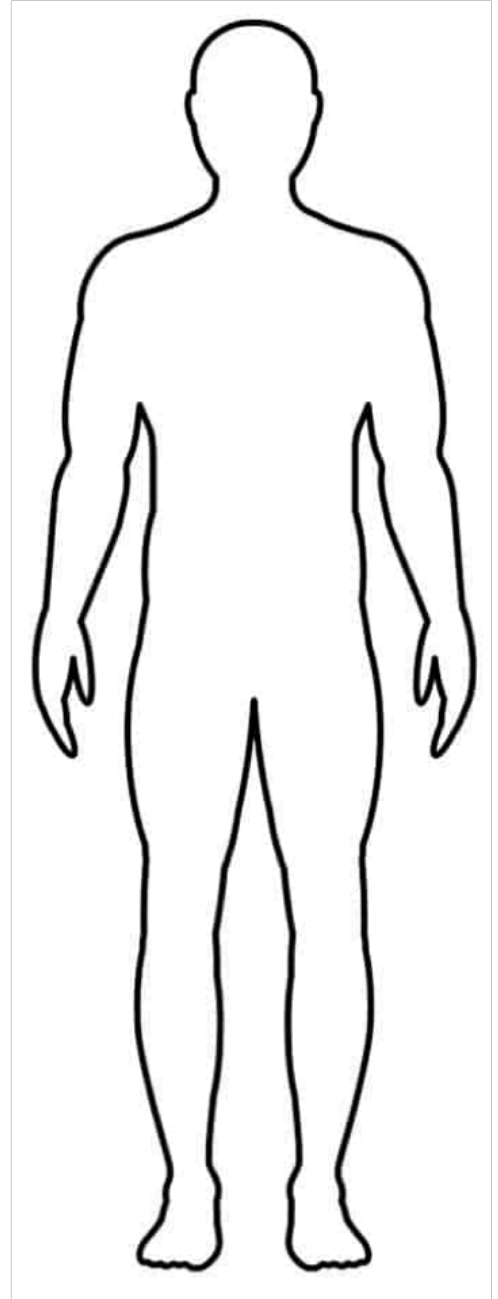
18. Which of these pictures of sin resonates the most for you?
